Spotify is a music app you can use on your phone or computer. First, you need to download the Spotify app. Open the app store, search for Spotify, and(1) "Download."
After downloading, open the app. If you do not have an(2) you need to sign up. Click "Sign Up" and fill in your email, create a(3), and enter your name and date of birth. If you already have an account, click "Log In."
Once inside the app, you see many songs and(4). You can search for your favorite music by typing the name of a song, artist, or album in the search bar.
When you find a song you like, you can tap the play button to listen. You can also create your own playlist. To do this, go to "Your Library," tap "Create Playlist," give it a name, and add your favorite songs.
Spotify also has a feature called "Discover Weekly." This playlist(5) every Monday and gives you new music based on what you like.
You can use Spotify for free, but there are(6) If you do not want ads, you can try Spotify Premium. With Premium, you can download songs to listen offline and(7) as many songs as you want.

Spotify helps you find new music. One way is through "Discover Weekly." This is a special list of songs just for you. It changes every Monday. It has songs Spotify thinks you will like. To find it, go to "Home." Move down until you see "Made For You." Touch it. You will see "Discover Weekly" there. Touch the list to listen to the new songs.

You can save songs you like from Discover Weekly to your own list. Just touch the three dots next to the song. Choose "Add to Playlist." Pick the list where you want to save the song. This way, you can keep all the songs you like in one place. You can listen to them any time you want.

Making a playlist on Spotify is not hard. First, open Spotify on your phone or computer. Look at the bottom of the screen. You will see 'Your Library'. Tap on it. Then, you will see a plus sign (+) or 'Create Playlist'. Tap on that.

Now you can name your playlist. Type a name you like. Tap 'Create'. Your new playlist is ready. You can put songs in it. To add a song, find one you like. Tap the three dots next to the song. You will see a menu. Choose 'Add to Playlist'. Pick your new playlist from the list. The song is now in your playlist. Do this again to add more songs.
